The following core values guide the mission of Bear Creek Community Charter School:


1. Setting high expectations for academic achievement will lead students to be meaningful contributors to society;
2. We have an obligation to expose children to content-rich materials and programs derived from research-based teaching methods;
3. Engaging children at all levels will inspire them to rise to academic challenges and develop a life-long enthusiasm for learning;
4. Quality teachers are critical to student achievement;
5. Staff will be provided the resources necessary to support their success and be held accountable for delivering measurable results;
6. Education is powerful when students, families, school, and the community are involved;
7. Children must be taught their inherent responsibility to respect the environment and will encourage others to do the same;
8. Children will be challenged to develop leadership skills, build self-esteem and exhibit exemplary character;
9. A safe and nurturing environment is essential to student achievement; and
10. Complacency is not acceptable. We must create and embrace a culture of continuous improvement for the benefit of our students.

What Are Public Charter Schools?

Charter schools were created to provide opportunities for teachers, parents, students and community members to establish and maintain schools that operate independently from the existing school district structure as a method to accomplish the following: improve student learning; increase learning opportunities for all students; encourage the use of different and innovative teaching methods; create new professional opportunities for teachers; provide parents and students with expanded choices in the types of educational opportunities that are available within the public school system; and be accountable for meeting measurable academic standards. Charter schools are exempt from many educational mandates. Some of the mandates that charter schools are not exempt from include health and safety, special education, civil rights, student accountability, employee criminal history checks, open meetings, freedom of information requirements, generally accepted accounting principles, and certain provisions of the Pennsylvania School Code.

Public charter schools like Bear Creek Community Charter School are independent public schools established and operated under a charter from the local school board and in which students are enrolled or attend. These schools are commonly referred to as "brick-and-mortar" charter schools and focus on teacher-led discussion and teacher knowledge imparted to students through face-to-face interaction at the schools' physical facilities located within the boundaries of the school district that granted the charter. A cyber charter school is an independent public school established and operated under a charter from PDE and in which the school uses technology in order to provide a significant portion of curriculum and to deliver a significant portion of instruction to its students through the internet or other electronic means without a school-established requirement that students be present at a supervised physical facility designated by the school, except on a very limited basis, such as for standardized test.

Charter schools and cyber charter schools must be organized as public, nonprofit corporations. Charter schools do not charge tuition. Any student residing in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is eligible to attend.

Bear Creek Community Charter School provides students in first through fourth grade the opportunity to participate in K-Kids Club, which is an after-school activity where students typically meet once a month in the Dining Hall from 3:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. A snack and drink are provided. K-Kids is a student-led service organization for elementary school students. The local Kiwanis Club of Wyoming Area serves as the K-Kids club sponsor. Members in this service organization are students who are interested in service to school and community.

The objectives of K-Kids are:

- To develop leadership potential
- To foster development of a strong moral character
- To encourage loyalty to school, community, and nation

Students in fifth through eighth grade the opportunity to participate in Builder's Club, which is an after-school activity where students typically meet once a month in the Dining Hall from 3:45 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. A snack and drink are provided.

Builders Club is an international student-led organization providing members with opportunities to perform service, build character and develop leadership for students in grades fifth to eighth. The local Kiwanis Club of Wilkes-Barre serves as the Builders Club sponsor.

Attendance & Truancy

Students cannot fully benefit from Bear Creek Community Charter unless they are in school participating in daily lessons, hands-on learning, and other critical aspects of the School's educational program. Ensuring acceptable attendance is a partnership between school, parent and student.

As a public school, Bear Creek Community Charter School enforces Pennsylvania's Compulsory School Attendance Law (24 P.S. §§ 13-1326 – 1354). Through a partnership with the Luzerne County Court of Common Pleas and Catholic Social Services Parent And Student Success Program (PASS), the goal is to improve student attendance and success through the engagement of students and their families in the educational process, and provide additional community supports for families on an as-needed basis.



Student Academic Growth



Bear Creek Community Charter School utilizes a number of assessments at various grade levels that are administered at various points throughout the year, to measure a student's academic growth, including iReady Diagnostic Benchmark Assessment, the Pennsylvania Classroom Diagnostic Tools (CDT), and the Pennsylvania Value-Added Assessment System (PVAAS).

PVAAS (Pennsylvania Value-Added Assessment System) measures student growth from one year to the next, based on state assessment performance. In this sense, growth for one student compares a student's performance on an assessment to their performance on earlier assessments. The state assessments used in PVAAS analysis include the PSSA and the Keystone exams. The Pennsylvania Department of Education works with SAS, an analytics firm, to develop and calculate PVAAS measures and metrics and then provides comprehensive growth data to public schools through Pennsylvania, including Bear Creek Community Charter School.

Value added or growth information can be used along with performance results for a more complete picture of student learning. Prior testing information is used by the state to predict student progress, and color-coded PVAAS reports show if groups exceeded, maintained or fell short of their expected growth.




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
Student Academic Performance

The annual Pennsylvania System School Assessment is a standards-based, criterion-referenced assessment which provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards. These standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science and Technology identify what a student should know and be able to do at varying grade levels. School districts possess the freedom to design curriculum and instruction to ensure that students meet or exceed the standards' expectations.

Every Pennsylvania student in grades 3 through 8 is assessed in English Language Arts and Math. Every Pennsylvania student in grades 4 and 8 is assessed in science. Testing usually occurs during the second half of April and into the first week of May each year. In compliance with §4.51(a)(4) of the PA School Code the State Board of Education approved, "specific criteria for advanced, proficient, basic and below basic levels of performance." Each year, the Department of Education provides the parent of each student taking one or more of the PSSA tests a student report explaining how their child performed on the PSSA assessment.

Why do parents choose Bear Creek Community Charter School for their children?

Since Bear Creek Community Charter School is a public school and does not charge tuition, parents can now choose between their traditional public school or Bear Creek Community Charter School, and do not have to worry about the costs associated with private school tuition.

Parents choose Bear Creek Community Charter School because . . . they embrace and support high academic expectations for their children – the same high academic expectations Bear Creek Community Charter School demands of its students. The Board of Trustees, administration and staff are uniformly committed to preparing students to leave Bear Creek Community with the best public education possible, to prepare them for high school, college and the real world beyond.

. . . . they want their children to get a solid understanding and appreciation for the natural environment in which we all live, and learn how to sustain our environment for future generations. Environmental Education is a key component of Bear Creek Community Charter School's academic program. Ecology and Environmental Science is woven into the academic fabric of the school, and each student receives dedicated instructional time specific for environmental education, in addition to the traditional Science coursework..

. . . of the small, safe and community-oriented environment created by our nurturing staff. Our dedicated and caring staff is committed to each child's academic success, and they go out of our way to ensure all children feel welcome. Parents choose Bear Creek Community Charter School because it openly embraces true parental involvement.

Student Retention & Promotion

Bear Creek Community Charter School Policy states that promotion from one grade to the next is a two-step process. Students will be considered for promotion upon (1) teacher recommendation and (2) students earning a passing grade in Math, English Language Arts and at least one of the two remaining core academic subjects. Students who are absent from school for thirty (30) or more days may be retained and not promoted to the next grade level.

Parent Satisfaction

School Finance

Bear Creek Community Charter School employs a licensed Certified Public Accountant as the School's Business Manager. Typically, Bear Creek Community Charter School's Business Manager prepares monthly financial statements, which are presented to the Chief Executive Officer for review, which are then presented to the Board of Trustees for approval. Each year, the School engages a Certified Public Accounting Firm to complete an independent audit of the School's financial statements. The audit is conducted in accordance with the auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

The School's Annual Independent is a public document and is posted on the School's web site at www.bearcreekschool.com. A copy is also provided to the Pennsylvania Department of Education and the Wilkes-Barre Area School District, Bear Creek Community Charter School's authorizing school district.

The independent audit for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 has not yet been completed. The information below is for the immediate prior fiscal years.

Fund Balance

Generally, a fund balance is the difference between a school's assets and its liabilities. In addition to cash in the bank and investments, a fund balance also includes money owed to, or by, the school and the value of items in inventory that will be collected, paid and/or used in the current fiscal year.

Three types of fund balances are reported to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

1. Committed – funds that have been dedicated by the school board for a specific purpose;
2. Assigned – funds that are intended for a specific purpose by a committee of the school board or an individual authorized by the board;
3. Unassigned – funds that are available for any purpose.

Schools will often commit or assign money in their fund balance to offset the cost of large expenditures, such as construction projects, renovations, or for expenses related to employee pensions.


Money that is unassigned is equivalent to a “rainy day” fund and is typically used for unexpected expenses, such as responding to an emergency or fulfilling a revenue shortfall, such as a change in the charter school funding calculation or a delayed state budget.

Campus & Facilities

Bear Creek Community Charter School is located on a 312-acre mountain top campus; of which 96 is utilized for school operations. The School consists of an original 65,000 school building constructed in 2015 and a 36,000 classroom expansion constructed in 2023. In addition, the campus includes maintenance facilities, pavilion, soccer field, two playgrounds, multiple ponds, yurt, nature trails and outdoor classrooms. Ten Mile Run, a high-quality cold-water fishery runs through the campus. The playground and nature trails are open to the public when school is not in session, and the pavilion is available for public rental.







ECO Explorations

Environmental Education

A key component of Bear Creek Community Charter School's is the cultivation of environmental stewardship, and one of the School's core values is to teach children about their inherent responsibility to respect the environment and use them as a conduit to help others do the same. Environmental education teaches children and adults how to learn about and investigate their environment, and to make intelligent, informed decisions about how they can take care of it.

Learning about the environment involves many subjects—earth science, biology, chemistry, social studies, even math and language arts—because understanding how the environment works, and keeping it healthy, involves knowledge and skills from many disciplines. When taught effectively, environmental education not only leads to environmentally literate children, but also helps increase student academic achievement.

Environmentally literate students understand that their daily choices affect the environment, how those choices can help or harm the environment, and what they need to do (individually or as part of a larger community) to keep the environment healthy and sustain its resources, so that people enjoy a good quality of life for themselves and their children.

Environmental literacy also promotes human health. Clean air reduces the incidence of asthma and certain cancers. Clean water prevents infectious diseases. Sustainable farming means nutrient-rich soil and healthier food for everyone. Environmentally literate people act on their beliefs. This might mean buying "green" products for the household, using natural alternatives to pesticides to protect gardens and homes, attending community meetings to discuss complex issues affecting the environment.

Bear Creek Community Charter School's comprehensive ECO Explorations curriculum provides all students in all grades, kindergarten through eight, hand-on learning opportunities throughout the year. Students receive a separate 45-minute block of instruction each week, engage in annual "field experiences" related to their course of student, and have opportunities to participate in afterschool and extra-curricular activities to support the School's mission of environmental stewardship.





After-School Tutoring

Elementary and middle school students are laying the foundation for successful learning skills that will carry them through their entire academic journey. Tutoring cannot only help young learners boost grades, but also helps them learn valuable skills, build self-confidence, and set them on a path for success. Bear Creek Community Charter School typically offers free, after-school tutoring during two six-week sessions twice a year, Fall and Spring. Tutoring typically focuses on Math, Reading and Writing skills. Students are identified for tutoring by their classroom teacher, and invitations and permissions slips are sent home for parent approval. If space permits, other students may also attend.

Positive Behavior Support

Bear Creek Community Charter School has a formal program to promote and reward positive behavior among students. Students in kindergarten through third grade earn points using the LiveSchool system and are then provided with the opportunity to “cash in” points for rewards as part of the prize shed. Students in fourth grade through eighth grade earn points using the LiveSchool system and are then provided with the opportunity to “cash in” points for either an “experience” or for one of multiple raffles for items such as electronics, hockey tickets, surprise boxes and more.

R.E.A.D. Therapy Dog

The mission of the R.E.A.D. program is to improve the literacy skills of children through the assistance of registered therapy teams as literacy mentors. R.E.A.D. is the first and foremost program that utilizes therapy animals to help kids improve their reading and communication skills and also teaches them to love books and reading. Bear Creek Community Charter School is blessed to have Mrs. Soroka and Rooney as our R.E.A.D. team, who work with the Literacy Specialist and classroom teachers to identify students who can benefit from this valuable resource.

Leaving the Den

Each year, Bear Creek Community Charter School hosts a special evening of activities for seventh and eighth grade students and their parents. Various schools and organizations from across the Wyoming Valley and beyond present information to families about options for students who are graduating 8th grade. This includes traditional public schools, private and parochial schools, and colleges and universities. Students and parents also learn about the benefits of dual enrollment, earning college credits while completing high school.

Student Showcase

Each Spring, Bear Creek Community Charter School hosts a family engagement event that allows students to showcase some of their work. This includes National History Day presentations, creative artwork, and more.

Birdhouse Buddies

A peer-led project sponsored by the Bear Creek Community Charter School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, this after-school activity provided students with the opportunity to learn more about birds, their nesting and feeding habits, and how they survive. Students then constructed their own birdhouse which they were encouraged to take home and place in a location that would attract birds to their own backyard.

Birds & Herps

This after-school activity was coordinated by Bear Creek Community Charter School's Outdoor Club. Students and parents were invited to join naturalists from the Greater Wyoming Valley Audubon Society, Kings College and Wilkes University on a walking tour of camps, to identify native bird specials, frogs, turtle and amphibians.

Spring Festival

Each year, the Bear Creek Community Charter School Parent/Teacher Organization sponsors the Annual Spring Festival, a day full of activities and fun for all Bear Creek Community Charter School students. Activities include educational presentations, water balloons, face-painting, sand art, games, crafts, snacks and more.
