Bear Creek Community Charter School is seeking a handful of parent volunteers to make weekly phone calls to elected officials in Harrisburg, delivering a message in support of public charter schools. This is a two-hour commitment for one day a week, or every other week. You can make the calls from home, or you can come to the school to make the calls. The only thing you need is time, pleasant voice, and a telephone (unless you come to the school and use our telephones). Calls must be made Monday through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. We will provide you with the names and telephone numbers of the offices to call, along with a script of just a few lines. All you have to do is make the call, tell them you are a parent of a charter school student, and recite the script. Since you will be talking to an office staffer, they will normally just jot down the message and thank you for your call.
