- ☐ **Monday- Young Eco Explorers (Students entering into 1st or 2nd grade)**  
Have your young explorer come out and get their hands dirty looking for all the fun critters we have on our campus. They will learn how to ask investigative questions, problem-solve, and work together with others to make conclusions from their observations. These explorers will get to make their own game from nature too!
- ☐ **Tuesday- Creekside Crafts(Students entering into 3rd or 4th grade)**  
Students will go on a short hike to our creek. We will then have various crafts for them to choose from. The crafts can include painting, weaving, and rock art.
- ☐ **Wednesday- Garden Explorers (Students entering into 5th- 8th grade)**  
These explorers will learn about starting their own vegetable or flower garden. They will learn about the different needs of each plant and how to read and understand the information on seed packets. Explorers will come home with their very own plant too!
