Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that we will once again be able to provide select students with an opportunity to participate in a week-long summer Nature Camp at Bear Creek Camp. Please refer to the information included with this letter. This Campership opportunity is sponsored by the Bear Creek Foundation.

Bear Creek Camp is located just one mile from the School and consists of over 3,000 acres of wilderness. It is truly an asset to our community. Bear Creek Camp offers wonderful educational opportunities for students to engage in hands-on learning about the natural world during summer break. Day camps are held Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with a snack and lunch provided daily. Aftercare is also available. This opportunity is available to Bear Creek Community Charter School students currently in **third, fourth, fifth, sixth or seventh grade**. This is a competitive program, and not all students who apply will be selected. Selection criteria will include a student's behavior and/or discipline record, financial need, student ambition & interest in the environment, attendance at school, and teacher referral, among others. An essay is also required from each applicant, and the successful applicants will be asked to share their experiences with fellow students when they return to school in the fall.

**Parents interested in applying for a 2026 Campership should complete and sign the enclosed form, and return it to the attention of Mrs. Larissa Soroka at the School, no later than Friday, March 6, 2026.** Students selected to receive a Campership will be notified no later than the week of March 16<sup>th</sup>. Students who are selected must then complete and return camp registration paperwork no later than Friday, March 27, 2026.

Before submitting a request for a Campership, parents must ensure their child is able and willing to attend the Nature Camp, for the entire week of their choice. This requires parents providing transportation to and from Bear Creek Camp for five consecutive days. We want to ensure as many students as possible benefit from the limited funds available; therefore, parents of students who "back out" after receiving a Campership and submitting their registration paperwork will be responsible for reimbursing Bear Creek Community Charter School a \$235.00 camp fee.

- ☐ **Fishing Frenzy: June 29- July 3.** Who lives in our streams, vernal pools & lake? Whether you're a seasoned angler or beginner, we will start you off with the basics from casting to tying lines. Learn about PA's fish and enjoy time practicing your fishing skills. Feel free to bring your own tackle/rod or we have some to share.
- ☐ **Nuts About Nature: July 13 - July 17.** For those who have a deep appreciation for nature's beauty! We will explore ecosystems where every leaf, rock and stream have a tale to tell. We will learn about local wildlife and encourage a sense of stewardship and appreciation for the environment.
- ☐ **Wilderness Survival: July 27 - July 31.** Learn basic survival skills such as shelter building, fire starting, outdoor safety and other skills to provide personal growth in the outdoors. We will have fun creating our own survival base camp.

Camps begin at 8:30 a.m. daily and conclude at 3:00 p.m. Aftercare is available through the Bear Creek Camp. The Bear Creek Foundation is only providing funding for the camp experience. I understand that Camperships are competitive in nature and not all students who apply will be provided a Campership. I understand that I am responsible for providing transportation to and from the Bear Creek Camp for five days of camp. I further understand that if my child fails to attend camp after receiving a Campership, I am responsible for reimbursing Bear Creek Community Charter School \$235.00 for the week, or \$47.00 for each day of camp my child does not attend. I hereby release both the Bear Creek Foundation and Bear Creek Community Charter School from any and all liability associated with my child's participation in Summer Day Camp provided by the Bear Creek Camp.
