

PARENT NOTIFICATION

I hope this letter finds you safe and well. As we get closer to entering week four of school closures in Pennsylvania, we have started to plan for a potentially longer closure, if deemed necessary. The teachers and staff have been hard at work planning for the future. To this end, we sent out an additional survey regarding technology and our teachers have been following up with any family who has not completed the survey.

Work for week three will be in the form of iReady lessons for Math and Reading. Students that do not have access to technology should complete any remaining work in the packets previously provided. Moving forward, we have arranged for continuity of education which includes enrichment and review. Students have been identified and grouped based on grade level and access to technology. Students in kindergarten through fourth form one group. Students in grades five through eight identified as having consistent access to technology form group two, and students in grades five to eight having limited or no access to technology form group three. Please see each section below for additional information. All students will be provided with the enrichment and review materials best suited for them.

Students in Kindergarten through Fourth Grade

Students in kindergarten through fourth grade will be receiving paper packets of review and enrichment materials for the month of April. Packets will be available for pickup outside the school on Thursday, April 2, 2020 between 1:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Packets will be mailed to families who are unable to pick up their packets at school. Students with internet access will also have the option of completing iReady lessons, in addition to the printed material provided by teachers.

Teachers will also post a video on their webpage each Monday morning by 11:00 a.m. These videos can be accessed by visiting <u>www.bearcreekschool.com</u> and selecting *Teacher Web Pages* from the Faculty dropdown. The Monday morning video will provide parents and students with a summary of the activities students will be completing in their packets for the week, as well as additional helpful information from the teacher.

In addition, teachers will be hosting virtual meetings with students and parents on Thursdays and Fridays utilizing the Zoom software, be sure to check with your monthly calendar for more details. Information regarding times of the meetings and how to join will be provided on the monthly calendar accompanying each student packet. Zoom meetings are designed for teachers, parents and students to check in with each other and discuss any questions about the work assigned. Zoom meetings can be joined using a computer, tablet, smartphone or by dialing in via phone.

Students in Grades Five through Eight with Limited or No Access to Technology

Students in grades five through eight with limited or no technology will receive a paper packet for the month of April. Packets will be available for pickup outside the school on Thursday, April 2, 2020 between 1:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Packets will be mailed to families who are unable to pick up their packets at school.

The work students complete in packets will be of similar content to that provided in Google Classroom. For example, in English Language Arts, students will all be reading the same novel but may be completing different activities to accompany the novel.

Teachers will also post a video on their webpage each Monday morning by 11:00 a.m. These videos can be accessed by visiting <u>www.bearcreekschool.com</u> and selecting *Teacher Web Pages* from the Faculty dropdown. For example, in English Language Arts, students will all be reading the same novel but may be completing different activities to accompany the novel.

Teachers will post work each week. Teachers will also post a video on their webpage each Monday morning by 11:00 a.m. These videos will provide parents and students with a summary of the activities students will be completing in their packets for the week, as well as additional helpful information from teachers.

Teachers will also host virtual meetings with students using Google Meet throughout the week. Information regarding times of the meetings and how to join will be provided in Google Classroom. Google Meets are designed for teachers, parents and students to check in with each other with any questions about the work assigned. Google Meets can be joined using a computer, tablet, smartphone or by dialing in via phone.
