Bear Creek Camp Nature Day Camp

Located in beautiful Bear Creek Township, the Bear Creek Camp is operated by the Eastern Pennsylvania Synod of the Lutheran Church in America, the Bear Creek Camp has been in operation since 1974. Nature Day Camp programs range from three to five days in length and are centered on specific environmental themes. From catching critters in local streams to searching for birds high in trees, campers will explore the world around them. Campers experience fun while learning, including hiking, aquatic activities, games, arts and crafts, and more! As campers grow individually and as a group, they will discover ecological connections in the world around them.

Bear Creek Community Charter School receives funding from the Bear Creek Foundation to cover the cost associated with student participation. Camperships are limited, and information on specific camps available for the program, scheduling, and other pertinent details are announced each spring. Parents are responsible for daily transportation to and from Bear Creek Camp. Camperships are provided through a reimbursement process, after students complete the week-long nature day camp.

Grade Level: 3 through 8

Implementation Timeline: Annually. Apply in March/April and attend camp in June/July/August.
