



## Summer Campership Program Sci-Q Project Camp

### **The Sci-Q Project Campership**

The Sci-Q Project is a week-long camp organized by the Pocono Environmental Education Center (PEEC) and sponsored by Sanofi Pasteur, which is designed for aspiring scientists. The camp is held each summer at the Pocono Environmental Education Center located in the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area in the Pocono Mountains of Pennsylvania.

Students interact with local college professors, hand-picked for their fun, approachable nature, as they showcase their research in a variety of fascinating fields. They also share their personal stories about the challenges and rewards of becoming scientists.

Topics explored include engineering, geology, wildlife biology, thermodynamics, entomology, physics, chemistry, environmental science and science education. Participants conduct fieldwork on an ongoing scientific research project during the week, as well as participate in field drips.

Participation in the program is extremely limited, and students interested in participating must apply through the Pocono Environmental Education Center.

Bear Creek Community Charter School receives funding from the Bear Creek Foundation to cover the nominal cost associated with student participation. The majority of the program costs are funded directly by Sanofi Pasteur.
