- 6:01 pm - Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance spoken by Kim Rebovich
- 6:02 pm- Treasurer's Report: Kim Rebovich, Treasurer; no questions were asked.

- 6:05 pm – Maggie Cibello spoke to the Bruins Bingo, reporting that the totals of the day of sales as well as the ticket sales.
